- 2 This fireplace is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. The trim around the heater outlet becomes hot during heater operation. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m) from the front of the fireplace.
- 3 Extreme caution is necessary when the fireplace is used by or near children or people with disabilities and whenever the fireplace is left operating and unattended.
- 4 Always turn off the fireplace when it is not in use.

Placement

Installation Height

It is recommended that the bottom of the unit be mounted a maximum of 40" (102 cm) from the ground to maintain an optimized viewing angle of the flame.

A WARNING: The top of the fireplace must be installed a minimum of 24" (61 cm) from the ceiling.



Installation in a Bathroom

If this unit is installed in a bathroom, it must be protected by a GFCI receptacle or circuit. If a receptacle is used, it must be readily accessible.

This electrical appliance is NOT watertight. To prevent electric shock, it must be installed as to prevent water from entering unit, or installed away from showers, tubs, etc. Never locate fireplace where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.



Wi-Fi


For installations where the use of the Flame Connect app is desired, ensure the fireplace is located within range of a Wi-Fi network.



Installation of Overhanging Objects

For overhanging temperature-sensitive objects, such as a television, a mantel, or artwork, always follow the recommendations provided by its manufacturer for installation over a heater.

NOTE: Using normal heat mode, surfaces 10" (25 cm) above the fireplace will not exceed 40° C, as long as installation procedures are followed and heater inlet and outlet are not obstructed.





! NOTE: Two or more people are required for installation. Use the handles located at the top on both sides of the fireplace to maneuver the unit.








Alternate view for open-sided installation








WARNING: The installation of the electric fireplace must comply with the applicable Local and/or National Electrical Codes and utility requirements.

WARNING: This heater is not intended for use with an extension cord. Plug the cord directly into an appropriate grounded wall receptacle.

Amp circuit is recommended, rated for the appropriate voltage (120 V, 240 V). A dedicated circuit will be required if, after installation, the circuit breaker trips or fuse blows on a regular basis when the heater is operating. Additional appliances on the same circuit may exceed the current rating of the circuit breaker.

WARNING: The power cord option is only suitable for 120 V installations.




- 1. Remove the screws that secure the electrical cover.
 - If using the power cord, proceed to step 4, following the diagram for 120 V wiring.
- 2. Knock out the section of the wiring cover that is most suitable for your installation. Three knock-out options are provided.
- Secure a 1/2" (1.3 cm) approved strain relief on the electrical cover and route the wires through it.
- 4. Complete the wiring according to the chosen installation. Ensure all wire connections are tight.
- 5. Secure the electrical cover.






5 Place the firebox in the framing and level it





- 1. Lift the firebox into the opening in the frame using the handles on the back and sides of the fireplace.
- 2. Using the bubble level, ensure the firebox is level, adjusting as necessary.

6 Secure mounting brackets






Secure the mounting brackets at the top of the fireplace to the framing with the provided wood screws.

! NOTE: The mounting brackets are equipped with slots to allow small adjustments to fit the framing. Ensure both brackets are aligned.


Optional step: install the linking brackets (ONLY for linked installation)

Optional step: disconnect the heater (ONLY for installation with no heat)





NOTE: This option is not recommended for seasonal heat disabling. Temporary disabling of the heater can be achieved through the onboard control; see "Heat Disable" in *Operation* table for instructions.

Follow these instructions **only** when an installation without heat is required.

- 1. Locate the driver board. The heater hardware disconnect jumper location is labeled "1. HEAT".
- 2. Pull out the heater hardware disconnect jumper. Place it only on one of the pins, as shown.

Install the mirrored glass







- ⚠ CAUTION: The magnet at the top will hold the glass in place to facilitate installation. It is necessary to install the bracket to ensure the glass does not fall.
 - 1. Secure the suction cup to the reflective side of the mirrored glass (black edge goes at the top).
 - 2. Lift the mirrored glass and place it into the bottom slot at an angle, then tilt the mirrored glass into a vertical position.
 - 3. Align the bracket to two screw holes and secure with screws.



9 Install the side glass





! NOTE: The side glass should be installed even on closed-sided installations.

- 1. Secure the suction cup to the side glass to prevent fingerprints on the outside of the glass.
- 2. Slide the glass in from the from the front. Once it place it will drop to its final position.
- Clean the glass with a damp cloth and dry it with a lint free dry cloth. Ensure there are no debris or finger prints on the mirrored glass, inner sides of the side glass, or on the inner side of the front glass before you begin

10 Place tumbled glass and gravel

For best results when using the supplied glass media, arrange as follows:

- 1. Pour the white frosted glass on the ember bed closest to the mirrored glass.
- 2. Pour the amber frosted glass around the edge of the white frosted glass.
- 3. Pour the dark amber around the edge of the light amber frosted glass.
- 4. Pour the black frosted glass around the edge of the dark amber frosted glass.
- 5. Sprinkle the black and grey gravel over the glass media.







NOTE: It is possible to use custom media ornaments to decorate your firebox. The custom media must fit easily without scratching the glass or bowing the ember bed, and must not be composed of liquid, which could interfere with the safety of the firebox.

If removing any logs in the arrangement, the corresponding wire will need to be removed from the log expansion board, located under the ember bed. Each remaining wire must be plugged sequentially in the log expansion board, beginning with the J1 position.


11 Place the logs



- Connect the log to the connector with the corresponding label number, and place it as shown below.
 - **NOTE:** Even-numbered logs should be placed first, followed by odd-numbered logs.
- Place the large glass chunks to conceal the connectors.



12 Install the front glass and top grille








- 1. Ensure the suction cup is securely attached to the outer side of the front glass.
- 2. Using the suction cup to assist, gently place the front glass into the bottom slot at an angle, and tilt the glass into a vertical position.
- 3. Secure the top grille with the five provided screws.

⚠ CAUTION: The magnets at the top will hold the glass in place to facilitate installation. It is necessary to install the grille to ensure the glass does not fall.

13 Install the sill trim


NOTE: Magnets are used to secure the trim pieces.






Place the Dimplex sill trim on the bottom lip of the fireplace, ensuring the bracket on the trim is aligned to the left.

Optional step: install side brackets and trims (ONLY for open-sided installation)






For bay or corner installations, install the side trim on each open side.

- 1. Loosely install the four trim brackets on each side using the screws provided.
- 2. Before fastening the screws entirely, connect the magnetic trim pieces and align them to the top grille and bottom sill.
- 3. Continue fastening the screws until all the trims are aligned.

15 Finish installation





Finish the installation using the finishing materials of your choice.

A CAUTION: Do not drill into firebox housing.

NOTE: The fireplace trim is designed to be installed with 1/2" drywall or cement board. Other finishing materials can be used.

Optional step: Install the wall mount for remote control





- ▲ CAUTION: Check for pipes and cables behind the wall before drilling into the wall.
- 1. Place the wall mount in the desired location. Use a bubble level to ensure it is level. Mark the location of the holes.
- 2. Secure the wall mount using the anchors and screws, as required.
- 3. Snap on the cover to the wall mount.
- 4. Place the remote in the wall mount.

A WARNING: This electric firebox must be properly installed before it is used.

! NOTE: The fireplace will retain the previously used settings after a power interruption.

Heater Operation

This firebox operates with Comfort\$averTM technology, which automatically adjusts the fan speed and heater wattage to safely and precisely match the requirements of the room based on the thermostat setting. If the temperature in the room rises significantly, the heater will turn off and periodically turn back on to circulate the air around the unit, until the room temperature drops and requires the heater to be on again.



NOTE: The element retains heat after shutdown. When the heat is turned off, there is a 20-minute cool down period before the fan shuts off completely.

Resetting the Temperature Cutoff Switch

Should the heater overheat, a manual limit cut-out will turn the unit off and it will not come back on without being reset. It can be reset by turning the unit off at the main power switch and waiting 30 minutes before turning the unit back on.



A CAUTION: If you need to continuously reset the heater, turn the unit off at the main disconnect panel and contact technical support.



To add the fireplace to the Flame Connect app:

- Press and hold ${\mathscr S}$ on the onboard controls for 10 seconds until it flashes blue.
- 2. Follow the instructions in the app to complete the installation.

Remote control

The fireplace is supplied with a multifunction Bluetooth remote.



To synchronize the remote control:

In case of lost connection or remote control replacement, follow these steps to synchronize the remote control to the fireplace:

- 1. Remove the battery cover on the remote control using a Philips screwdriver to access the O button.
- 2. Press and hold 0 on the onboard controls for five seconds and, within ten seconds, press \bigcirc on the remote.

NOTE: One remote can control multiple units. Repeat the steps above with each fireplace to sync the remote.





To link multiple units together:

On the primary fireplace, press $0, 0, \underline{\mathbb{M}}, \underline{\mathbb{M}}, \mathcal{S}, \mathcal{S}$. Within 20 seconds, press 0, 0, 11, 11, 11, 0 on the secondary fireplace. This must be done using the onboard controls.

Maintenance

Remote control battery replacement


To replace the battery:

- 1. Remove the battery cover on the remote control using a Philips screwdriver.
- 2. Install two AAA batteries in the battery holder.
- 3. Secure the battery cover.

Fireplace surface cleaning

Use only a damp cloth to clean painted surfaces of the fireplace. Do not use abrasive cleaners.



The fireplace should not be operated with an accumulation of dust or dirt on or in the unit, as this can cause a build-up of heat and eventual damage. For this reason the heater must be inspected regularly, depending upon conditions and at a minimum yearly intervals.







This Limited Warranty applies to your newly purchased Dimplex electric fireplace with model numbers ULT50-AM, ULT60-AM, ULT74-AM, ULT88-AM, and ULT100-AM.

This Limited Warranty applies only to purchases made in any province of Canada except for Yukon Territory, Nunavut, or Northwest Territories or in any of the 50 States of the USA and the District of Columbia except for Hawaii and Alaska. This Limited Warranty applies to the original purchaser of the product only and is not transferable.

Section 2 Products excluded from this Limited Warranty

Products purchased in Yukon Territory, Nunavut, Northwest Territories, Hawaii, or Alaska are not covered by this Limited Warranty. Products purchased in these States, Provinces, or Territories are sold AS IS without Warranty or condition of any kind including, without limitation, any implied warranties or conditions of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. The entire risk of as to the quality and performance of the products is with the purchaser. In the event of a defect, the purchaser assumes the entire cost of all necessary servicing or repair.

Section 3 What this Limited Warranty covers and for How Long

Dimplex products ULT50-AM, ULT60-AM, ULT74-AM, ULT88-AM, and ULT100-AM, excluding trims and accessory packages are covered by this Limited Warranty, have been tested and inspected prior to shipment and, subject to the provisions of this Warranty, Glen Dimplex Americas Ltd. (herein called Glen Dimplex Americas) warrants such products to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 5 years from the date of the first purchase of such products. The 5-year Limited Warranty entitles the purchaser to On-site or In-home Warranty Services. Accordingly, Glen Dimplex Americas will be responsible for all labor and transportation associated with repairing or replacing the product or part. Exceptions to this are outlined in Section 5. Some jurisdictions do not allow limitations on how long an implied Warranty lasts, so the above limitation may not apply to the purchaser.

Section 4 What this Limited Warranty Does Not Cover

This Limited Warranty does not apply to products that have been repaired (except by Glen Dimplex Americas or its authorized service representatives) or otherwise altered. This Limited Warranty does further not apply to defects resulting from misuse, abuse, accident, neglect, incorrect installation, improper maintenance or handling, or operation with an incorrect power source.

Section 5 How to notify us of a Warranty Concern

Defects must be brought to the attention of Dimplex Customer Service online at dimplex.com/en/contact_us or by telephone at 1-888-346-7539. Please have proof of purchase, catalogue/model and serial numbers available for representatives to assist. **Limited In-home Warranty Services require proof of purchase.

In the event a product or part covered by this Limited Warranty is proven to be defective in material or workmanship during (i) the 5-year Limited Warranty period for products outlined in Section 1, you have the following rights:

- Glen Dimplex Americas will in its sole discretion either repair or replace such defective product or part without charge. If Glen Dimplex Americas is unable to repair or replace such product or part, or if repair or replacement is not commercially practicable or cannot be timely made, Glen Dimplex Americas may, in lieu of repair or replacement, choose to refund the purchase price for such product or part.
- Limited Warranty service will be performed solely by dealers or service agents of Glen Dimplex Americas authorized to provide Limited Warranty services.
- This 5-year Limited Warranty entitles the purchaser to On-site or In-home Warranty services. Accordingly, Glen Dimplex Americas will be responsible for all labor and transportation associated with repairing or replacing the product or part except as follows: (i) charges which may be levied for travel costs incurred to travel to the purchaser's site where the product is located if the purchaser's site is beyond 30 miles (48 km) from the closest service depot of Glen Dimplex Americas dealer or service agent; and (ii) the purchaser is solely responsible for providing clear access to all serviceable parts of the product.
- Glen Dimplex Americas will not be responsible for, and this Limited Warranty shall not include, any expense incurred for installation or removal of the surrounds (mantels) or trims or any part thereof (or any replacement product or part) including, without limitation, all shipping costs and transportation costs to and from the authorized dealer's or service agent's place of business and all labor costs. Such costs shall be the purchaser's sole responsibility.

Section 6 When Glen Dimplex Americas and its Dealers and Service Agents are not Liable

IN NO EVENT WILL GLEN DIMPLEX AMERICAS, OR ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, OR AGENTS, BE LIABLE TO THE PURCHASER OR ANY THIRD PARTY. WHETHER IN CONTRACT, IN TORT, OR ON ANY OTHER BASIS FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR INCIDENTAL LOSS, COST, OR DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE, MAINTENANCE, USE, OR INABILITY TO USE THE PRODUCT, EVEN IF GLEN DIMPLEX AMERICAS OR ITS DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, OR AGENTS HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH LOSSES COSTS OR DAMAGES, OR IF SUCH LOSSES, COSTS. OR DAMAGES ARE FÓRESEEABLE. IN NO EVENT WILL GLEN DIMPLEX AMERICAS, OR ITS OFFICERS DIRECTORS, OR AGENTS BE LIABLE FOR ANY DIRECT LOSSES, CÓSTS, OR DAMAGES THAT EXCEED THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE PRODUCT. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO THE PURCHASER.

This Limited Warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. The provisions of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the Sale of Goods shall not apply to this Limited Warranty or the sale of products covered by this Limited Warranty.
